# Luminaries

Paper Create festive lights to spread joy in Bag your community on the winter solstice, December 211



### **MATERIALS**

two paper bags two battery-operated lights pencil black marker stencil

Feel free to use your kit bag for the Luminary!

you may need: scissors





## **INSTRUCTIONS**

1

Place the stencils under one section of the paper bag. Cut them out and move them around to where you want them.



2

Trace the stencil onto the paper bag. You can make your own drawing or try using cookie cutters as stencils!



3

Cut out the shapes or color them in with marker.







Turn on the tea light and put it in the bag. Don't use a real candle!



5

Put your luminaries in a window, on a porch, or in the driveway. Enjoy the little light you have added to the darkness, and all the other lights around town!

You can weigh down the luminary bag with stones or sand!
