LESTRADE. Look. You know how this works. SHERLOCK. Don't be. I understand. Come, Watson. We've no time to lose. We should leave the policeman to his crime scene. Good luck solving your case, Inspector Lestrade.

LESTRADE. You too, Miss Holmes.

(SHERLOCK exits. WATSON starts to follow.)

LESTRADE (cont'd). You had to tell her? WATSON. Yes.

LESTRADE. Fair enough.

(They smile at each other. WATSON exits. LESTRADE takes out his notebook.)

LESTRADE (cont'd). Right then.

(He goes back to one of the dirt smudges SHERLOCK pointed out and starts to take notes.

MYCROFT enters. He carries a portfolio with him.)

START LESTRADE (cont'd). Hey! I'm very sorry, you can't be in here. Police business.

MYCROFT. Inspector Lestrade. I believe it is past time we made each other's acquaintance.

LESTRADE. Appearing out of nowhere. Sinister introduction. I'm going to go out on a limb here and deduce that you must be Sherlock's brother. You just missed her.

LESTRADE. I don't want to be a part of your family squabbles, Mr. Holmes.

MYCROFT. Please, Inspector. Contrary to what she may have led you believe, I actually am concerned for her well-being.
